- Assist in incident investigations and the development of corrective actions
- Assist with the overall implementation of safety systems, strategies, initiatives and promote improvements to manager
- Conduct inductions, training, toolboxes and meetings as directed
- Develop, review and improve safety documentation, including policies and procedures
- Conduct Weekly emergency response training
- Co-ordinate communication and reporting through the safety system
- Conduct audits, safety inspections and risk management processes, make recommendations and develop actions
- Equipment preparedness including compliance, inspections and reporting.
- Conduct of site fitness for work requirements in accordance with site and company alcohol and other drugs policies.
- Plan, co-ordinate, and participate in site emergency drills.
- To provide first aid and medical services along with ensuring medical facilities are maintained in an operationally ready status.
- Oversee injury management and return to work cases
